

2016 National Convention Resolutions

FETAL ALCOHOL SPECTRUM DISORDER

That it be mandatory for all alcohol labels to have clear and prominently displayed warning messages in place such as "Alcohol may harm your unborn baby".

That the government implement a continuing national TV campaign, targeting all women to encourage no alcohol consumption when pregnant or planning a pregnancy.

PROSTITUTION

That the Nordic Model legislation be introduced in Australia to reduce human trafficking especially of women and children.

ALCOHOL

That all alcohol be taxed according to the percentage of alcohol in each product.

GAMBLING

That TV advertising of gambling during daylight sporting programs be banned.

REHABILITATION

That more rehabilitation facilities be made available for persons with addictions.

MEDICAL CANNABIS

That medical cannabis be treated in the same way as other medicines and be subject to the TGA.

SEXUALISATION OF CHILDREN

That the government set up a default filter for Telco companies to block porn sites (as they have done with movie download sites) with an opt out option.

That all out-door advertising be G rated.

That the government develop standards that eliminate sexualised advertising for children under 18 (print, clothing, television, electronic media etc.) with serious penalties for both wholesalers and retailers who breach these standards.
